Heacox (President):

- OLLI update: Maximum number of people in new classroom to be determined by Fire Marshall but expected number is 70-100.

- After OLLI selecting items from CCHHI's storage, unit will be emptied and payment stopped.

Fusaro (Education):

- Hilton Head Library Exhibit will run until Oct. 17. 54 photos are on display, generating \$270 in revenue and \$80 in expenses.
- Education Program 2015-16 has 4 confirmed classes: JM Cote: Photography 101 (3/6 weeks); Jerry Griffin: Small Lowcountry Birds, and Bob Ovelman: Use of Flash. More expert members are needed to teach, especially Competition Preparation. Requested comments and suggestions for classes such as a Preparation for Tri-Club Competition.
- One-day classes were also suggested as a way to meet needs of members on a variety of topics and taught by other members.

Parsons (Field Trips):

- CCHHI will again provide members' photos for the Lowcountry Through the Lens Exhibit at Honey Horn from May 5 to June 29, 2016 with a reception May 11 from 5 to 7:00 pm. 500 postcards will be mailed by the Coastal Discovery Museum to generate interest. 1/3 of the images must be of the Lowcountry theme. Suggested that submitting images digitally may keep members on track with theme and size limitations. Saturday gallery talks are planned. People's Choice Award was discussed as means of additional publicity midway through the exhibition. Award last year generated \$160 for Honey Horn as well as the 40% of sales of photos. Also a Scavenger Hunt was proposed to engage kids as they tour the exhibit. Bin art was also discussed.
- Field Trip to the Coastal Georgia Botanical Gardens at the Historic Bamboo Farm in Savannah is scheduled for Wed. Oct. 7 in preparation for the Grasses Competition at the October 27 meeting.
