#### **Utilize The Rule Of Thirds**

 The Rule of Thirds will help to compose a scene that brings the viewer into your image creating a well balanced image overall

\*Rule of Thirds: The image is divided evenly into thirds, both horizontally and vertically, the subject of the image is then placed at the intersection of those dividing lines, or along one of the lines itself


### **Use Leading Lines**
